

# Teversal, Stanton Hill and Skegby Neighbourhood Plan Referendum

## Information Statement

A referendum relating to the adoption of the Teversal, Stanton Hill and Skegby Neighbourhood Plan will be held on 12 October 2017.

The question to be asked in the Referendum is:

**“Do you want Ashfield District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Teversal, Stanton Hill and Skegby to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”**

The Referendum area is the same as the Teversal, Stanton Hill and Skegby Neighbourhood Area designated at the start of the Neighbourhood process. The Referendum area is identified on the map, which is included with this statement.

A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum if on 26 September 2017:

- He or she is entitled to vote in a local government election in the Referendum area; and
- His or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A persons qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The Referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the Referendum is **£2,772**. The number of persons entitled to vote in the Referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is **6,942**

The Referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures, similar to those used at local government elections.
