

Selston Neighbourhood Plan (known as the JUS-t Neighbourhood Plan) Referendum

Information Statement

A referendum relating to the adoption of the Selston Neighbourhood Plan (known as the JUS-t Neighbourhood Plan) will be held on 12 October 2017.

The question to be asked in the Referendum is:

“Do you want Ashfield District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Selston to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

The Neighbourhood Plan Area covers the Parish of Selston as at the 12th December 2013, the date it was designated, Map 1. It does not include the addition area of land included within the Parish from 1st December 2016. Follow the recommendation of the independent examiner, the Referendum area extends beyond the Selston Neighbourhood Plan Area to take in the additional area incorporated into the Parish of Selston from 1st December 2016. The Referendum area is identified on the map, which is included with this statement.

A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum if on 26 September 2017:

- He or she is entitled to vote in a local government election in the Referendum area; and
- His or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A persons qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The Referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the Referendum is **£2,961**. The number of persons entitled to vote in the Referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is **10,146**.

The Referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures, similar to those used at local government elections.

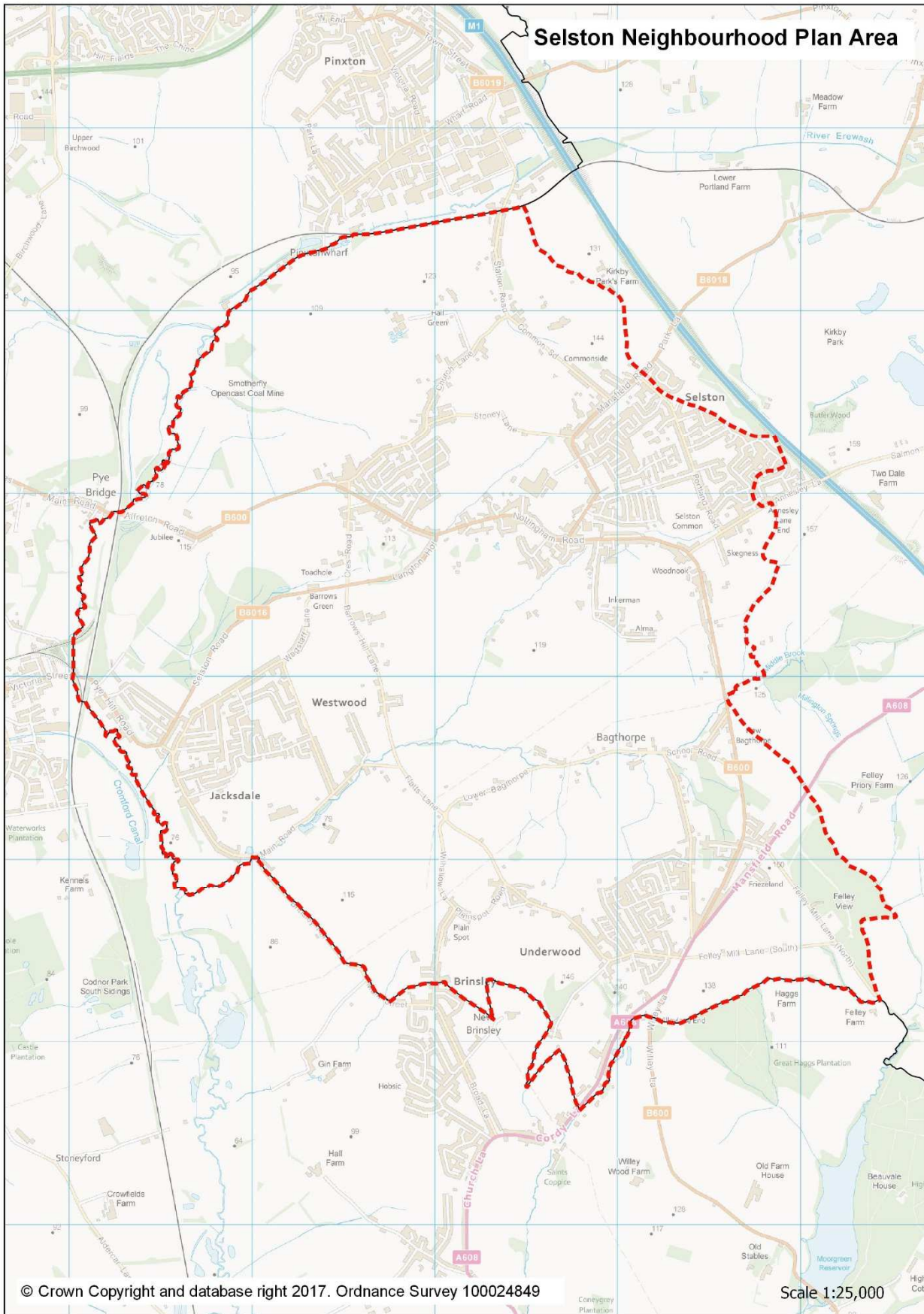
