

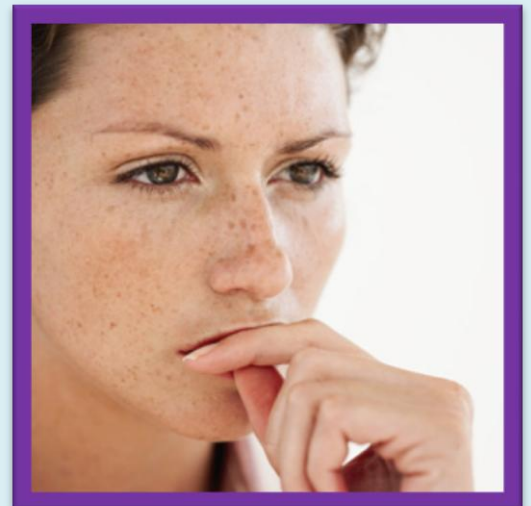


The Community Trigger

If you have complained about Anti-social behaviour (ASB) on three or more separate occasions either to the Council, Police or your housing provider then you may be able to use the Community Trigger. The problems you have reported must have taken place within the last six months and each incident reported within one month of it occurring.

The Community Trigger is a way that you can ask for your complaint of ASB to be reviewed if you feel your complaint has not been addressed appropriately.

The Community Trigger does not replace an organisations own complaints procedures and members of the public should still utilise the complaints procedure of an individual organisation if they are unhappy about the service they received or an individual officer.
