## What is the BIG Spring Clean?

We are rolling out The BIG Ashfield Spring Clean across the district as part of the Council's commitment to make Ashfield a cleaner place to live, work and visit. Residents are invited to have a clear out of their houses and dispose of their extra waste. Waste should be bagged and put out with your regular bin collection during the relevant week, on your usual collection day. As long as it is in a bin liner that will not split under excess weight and doesn't contain fluids, electrical items or hazardous material, we will collect it. Please note extra waste may not be collected at the same time as your bin.

You can dispose of any bulky waste items including settees, mattresses, white goods and fridges, by booking a free bulky waste collection with our Environment Team between 11th February and 1st March 2019. Maximum of three free items.

Flying Skips will be travelling and stopping at specified drop off points across the district. Residents are invited to bring additional waste items, including small furniture to the drop off points at specific times (right). Fridges cannot be accepted by the Flying Skips.
