



# FIRE ACTION

## IF A FIRE BREAKS OUT IN YOUR HOME

- ✓ IMMEDIATELY LEAVE THE ROOM WHERE YOU FOUND THE FIRE AND CLOSE THE DOOR TO THE ROOM BEHIND YOU
- ✓ TELL EVERYONE IN YOUR HOME, GET THEM TO LEAVE AND CLOSE THE ENTRANCE DOOR OF YOUR FLAT BEHIND YOU
- ✓ DO NOT STAY BEHIND OR ATTEMPT TO PUT THE FIRE OUT
- ✓ LEAVE THE BUILDING BY THE NEAREST SAFE EXIT AND NOTIFY THE FIRE BRIGADE (CALL 999 or 112)

## IF YOU SEE OR HEAR OF A FIRE IN ANOTHER PART OF THE BUILDING

- ✓ THE BUILDING IS DESIGNED TO CONTAIN A FIRE IN THE FLAT WHERE IT STARTS. THIS MEANS IT WILL USUALLY BE SAFE TO STAY IN YOUR OWN FLAT IF THE FIRE IS ELSEWHERE
- ✓ REMAIN IN THE NEAREST ROOM WITH THE DOOR CLOSED
- ✓ YOU MUST LEAVE IMMEDIATELY IF SMOKE OR HEAT AFFECTS YOUR HOME OR IF YOU ARE TOLD TO LEAVE BY THE FIRE SERVICE
- ✓ IF YOU ARE IN ANY DOUBT, LEAVE THE BUILDING

## CALL THE FIRE SERVICE

- ✓ DIAL 999 or 112 ASK FOR THE FIRE BRIGADE – SAY WHERE YOU ARE

**DO NOT TAKE RISKS**  
**DO NOT STOP TO COLLECT BELONGINGS**  
**DO NOT HEAD IN THE DIRECTION OF THE FIRE**  
**DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PUT OUT THE FIRE**  
**DO NOT RETURN TO YOUR HOME UNTIL YOU ARE INFORMED BY THE FIRE OFFICER THAT IT IS SAFE TO DO SO**
