- 5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Ashfield District Council Offices, Urban Road, Kirkby-in-Ashfield, Nottingham, NG17 8DA by 5 pm on Thursday, 12th October 2017. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 4th October 2017. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 4th October 2017
