

Fire Action



IF A FIRE BREAKS OUT IN YOUR HOME

LEAVE THE ROOM WHERE YOU FOUND THE FIRE AND CLOSE THE DOOR

ALERT EVERYONE IN YOUR HOME AND GET THEM TO LEAVE. CLOSE THE ENTRANCE DOOR OF THE FLAT BEHIND YOU

RAISE THE ALARM USING THE NEAREST BREAK GLASS CALL POINT (THIS WILL ALERT THE FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICE ALSO)

LEAVE THE BUILDING BY THE NEAREST SAFE EXIT

ASSEMBLE AT:

IF YOU SEE OR HEAR OF A FIRE IN ANOTHER PART OF THE BUILDING:

THE BUILDING IS DESIGNED TO CONTAIN A FIRE IN THE FLAT WHERE IT STARTS. THIS MEANS IT IS SAFE FOR YOU TO STAY IN YOUR OWN HOME IF THE FIRE IS ELSEWHERE. MAKE SURE THAT THE ENTRANCE DOOR TO YOUR HOME IS FULLY CLOSED

YOU MUST LEAVE THE BUILDING IMMEDIATELY IF SMOKE OR HEAT AFFECTS YOUR HOME OR IF YOU ARE TOLD TO LEAVE BY THE FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICE

IF YOU ARE IN ANY DOUBT, LEAVE THE BUILDING

DO NOT TAKE RISKS

DO NOT HEAD IN THE DIRECTION OF THE FIRE

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO TACKLE THE FIRE

DO NOT USE THE LIFT

DO NOT RETURN TO YOUR HOME UNTIL YOU ARE INFORMED BY

THE FIRE OFFICER THAT IT IS SAFE TO DO SO
